Working with Partners

Disease Control

- Assist with follow up investigations as needed (ex. Tuberculosis, Food-borne Illnesses, Rabies, etc.)

Environmental Health Program

- Information and referral to regional Environmental Health staff (ex. onsite sewers, nuisances, or facility inspections)

Emergency Preparedness and Response

- Work with local Emergency Managers & exercise planning, maintain local emergency plans for community response, attend tabletop, functional or full-scale exercises as requested

Immunizations

- offer recommended immunizations to people of all ages.
 - NGDHU is able to bill most insurances and immunizations are offered at no cost to uninsured or underinsured children and adults
- Monthly Immunization Clinics at 3 locations from 9:30am-10:30am
 - see back for additional details

Home Visits

- including medication setup or assessment/ monitoring of health conditions from birth to elderly

Office Visits

- including Blood Pressure Monitoring and Tobacco Cessation

School Health

- including vision screening for preschool-6th grade, or upon request
- health education including, nutrition education, Tobacco education, puberty/hygiene talks for 4th, 5th, and/or 6th graders, and dental/handwashing for Kindergartners
- We also maintain all student immunization records within our service area.

Child Safety

- Cribs for Kids and Child Passenger Safety (car seats) distributor
 - (qualification may apply)

- Health Education presentations to individuals and groups as requested
